## THE RULES

- > Every boat will have a team captain in it.
- > You must be in front of the landing by 1 pm for weigh in.
- > All Participants must wear a life vest while the boat is under power with the main motor.
- > All participants must follow the rules of the state of MN and any restrictions that WBL has in effect for catching and releasing species.
- > One pound penalty for dead FISH, dead meaning they show signs of not surviving after release from weigh-in.

> This is a multi-species tournament. 5 categories will be awarded 1st prize: Largest Northern Pike, Largest Bass, Largest Walleye, Largest stringer of pan fish and largest overall fish will be awarded trophy.

> Kids will be assigned to a boat and guide in a random manner the morning of tournament.

> Weigh-In during the day as you catch your fish so that you can release them right away. It is not required to weigh in each time you catch a fish.
