## RULES:

This is a multi-species fishing experience. Five (5) categories will be awarded a 1st prize trophy: largest Northern Pike, largest Bass, largest Walleye, largest stringer of pan fish and largest overall fish. Only children 18 and younger are eligible for prizes.

Special prizes will be awarded to any child 18 years or younger that catches a Muskie. No Muskie will be weighed but reports will be given and prizes presented during Awards Ceremony. One trophy limit per participant.

Kids and families will be assigned to a boat and guide in a random manner the morning of the event.

If registrations exceed number of boats, then fishing times will be limited to insure boat fishing for all registrants.

Dock fishing will be available throughout the day for all participants. Equipment will be available. Please inquire for special needs.

Weigh-In during the day as you catch your fish so that you can release it right away. It is not required to weigh-In each time you catch a fish.

All participants must follow the rules of the State of MN and any restrictions that Lake Minnetonka has in effect for catching and releasing species.

All participants must wear a life vest while the boat is under power of the main motor.

All Youth 16 and over are required to have a fishing license. A 1-day fishing license can be purchased at any bait shop.
